located on Lot # 76. Copied by Lee Kibbe in 1942

Claude Millers a few rods across the road south of the house enclosed by a crumbling stone fence, large maple trees standing in three on the corners.

1. Eliher Holland settled in 1814, d. March 1849 , age 80 y 6 days. He had long been a resident of this town and had held many offices of trust. His hands fell the timber and cultivated the soil upon which he now rests from his labor. Let it be preserved ??? to his memory forever.
